Directions

From Nashville: Take Interstate 40 west to Briley Parkway. Exit onto Briley Parkway and go right (west) toward Opryland. Exit Briley Parkway onto Interstate 65 North. Cross into Kentucky. Take exit #22. Turn left. Go two miles. Turn right on Wilkinson Trace.

From Louisville: Follow signs from the airport to Interstate 65 south. Take I-65 south to exit 22. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp. Go two miles. At stop light with #3 indicator, turn right. Hotel is ahead on your left.

From Lexington: Take Versailles Road to Bluegrass Parkway. Follow Parkway to I-65. Go South to exit 22. Turn right at end of exit ramp. Go two miles. At stop light with #3 indicator, turn right. Hotel is ahead on your left.

From Corbin: Take I-75 N. Take exit 41. Turn left and take KY-80 W (Russell S. Dyche Memorial Hwy.) toward Somerset. Continue onto Louie B Nunn Cumberland Parkway (toll required for some segments) Continue onto Exit 1B. Take I-65 S to exit 22. Turn right at end of exit ramp. Go two miles. At stop light with #3 indicator, turn right. Hotel is ahead on your left.

Mitchell Tolle

Mitchell Tolle is a Kentucky artist of national acclaim. He is also a motivational speaker and author of "*Like a Tree-A Radical Approach to Living The Good Life.*" Mitchell learned to draw at an early age, attended the Art Academy of Cincinnati for a year and after being drafted in the Vietnam era, became an artist for the U.S. Army. After a year in Thailand where he did paintings and drawings for the army, he and his wife, Linda, returned home and opened the Mitchell Tolle Studio and Gallery in Berea, Kentucky. Together they built his career and raised their three children, Mitchell, Jr., who now manages the Gallery, Michelle, and Misty.
