


GRREC Announces...

Day I will feature the highly acclaimed Dr. Marcia Tate of Developing Minds Inc. who has inspired teachers nationwide with her fast-paced, fun, and interactive presentation. Expect to be in high gear all day as Dr. Tate shares her twenty-one “best bet” instructional strategies and provides multiple activities that teachers can incorporate immediately. Joined by GRREC staff, teachers will provide a model for unit development and delivery which incorporate KDE's focus over the past couple of years on identifying “power” or “key” standards for high school mathematics. Participants will receive full copies of Algebra I Units on Equations, Linear Functions, Systems of Equations, and Non-Linear Functions including student work samples and assessments.
