The Green River Regional Educational Cooperative Exceptional Children Division is pleased to present *Autism & ABA: An Introduction to Discrete Trial Teaching* on Monday and Tuesday, July 13-14, 2015.

The presenter, Deb Myers, will briefly review the characteristics of autism and the more prominent interventions or evidence-based practices (EBPs) in the area of autism. The session will primarily focus on Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and Discrete Trial Teaching (DTT) interventions that schools are more frequently being asked to provide for students with autism. Participants will have an introduction to general ABA procedures as they pertain to effective interventions. A description of both verbal behavior and mass trial strategies will be provided with conditions on when to use. Day 1 will focus on specific DTT strategies and teaching methods. Day 2 will focus on what to teach and specific curriculum tools.

Note: Participants must attend Day 1 to attend Day 2.

The learning objectives for this training include:

- Awareness of the twenty-seven EBPs for ASD
- To identify the basic components of the DTT format
- To identify the seven key principles of ABA to teach using DTT procedures
- Awareness of curriculum guides that may assist in using discrete trial methods
- To identify the behavior classification of language based upon verbal behavior
- The importance of data collection and analysis to improve instruction

Debra Myers, Low Incidence Consultant/BCBA will lead participants through the two-day workshop.
