Cognitive Coaching<sup>SM</sup> is a form of mediation that can be applied to professional interactions in a variety of settings and situations with the intention of enhancing self-directed learning. It is a composite of skills, strategies, maps, and tools as well as mental models and beliefs. It is also a model for classroom mediation to enhance students' self-directed learning. Research on Cognitive Coaching<sup>SM</sup> has linked its implementation to increased student achievement, greater teacher efficacy and satisfaction, higher levels of teacher cognition and professional, collaborative cultures.

As a result of engaging in the Foundational Training (Part 1), participants will:

- Demonstrate interpersonal communication skills to develop trust and rapport.
- Conduct planning and reflecting coaching conversations.
- Demonstrate mediation skills and coaching capabilities.
- Demonstrate the coaching support functions of consulting, collaborating, and coaching.



Dr. Maggie B. McGatha is an associate professor of mathematics education at the University of Louisville. She is a former middle school mathematics teacher. She works with coaches, teacher leaders, and administrators as a Training Associate for Cognitive Coaching<sup>SM</sup> and an Agency Trainer for Adaptive Schools. She is a co-author of *Mathematics Coaching: Resources and Tools for Coaches and Leaders, K-12* and the forthcoming *Mathematics Activities to Build Financial Literacy, Grades 6-8*. She currently serves on the NCTM Educational Materials Committee. She has served as President of KCTM and a member of the Board of Directors for the Association of Mathematics Teacher Educators (AMTE).
