More than a 2-day training!

Personalized follow-up supports will be provided to meet individual educator needs. Options for these supports include face-to-face consultation, online webinars, virtual planning sessions and phone conferences.

Day 1: Developing the IEP: This session will provide direct instruction in using the Guidance Document as a guide for creating a meaningful data-driven individual education plan that is compliant and directly aligns with a student's individual needs, strengths, learning style, and goals. Each participant will leave with a toolkit of resources for writing the IEP.

Day 2: Implementing the IEP: Day 2 of the training will focus on implementation of the IEP and student outcomes. The day will be structured with mini-sessions on annual goals, data collection/progress monitoring, specially designed instruction, supplementary aids and services, assessment accommodations, least restrictive environment, and transition. Educators will have the opportunity to learn instructional strategies and create resources that they can incorporate in the classroom the very next day.
