Dr. Donna Brostek Lee is a Clinical Assistant Professor and Visual Impairment Program Faculty Chair at the University of Kentucky. Dr. Lee received her bachelor's degree in Elementary Education and Visual Impairments and her master's degree in Orientation and Mobility from Western Michigan University. She received her doctorate from the University of Louisville, with a focus on educational leadership in blindness and visual impairment. During Dr. Lee's doctoral program, she was a National Center for Leadership in Visual Impairment (NCLVI) fellow. Prior to coming to the University of Kentucky, she was an assistant professor at Western Michigan University.

Gerald Abner is a Clinical Instructor in the Visual Impairment Program at the University of Kentucky. Mr. Abner received his bachelor's degree in Art Education and education specialist degree in Assistive Technology from the University of Kentucky. He also received a master's degree in Visual Impairments from the University of Louisville. Mr. Abner has 28 years teaching experience in the field of blindness and visual impairments with a specialty in assistive technology.
