### About this training....

This 2-day event will kick off with Dr. Ruby Payne's keynote presentation on May 26<sup>th</sup> and will continue with workshop-style breakout sessions facilitated by GRREC certified trainers. These workshops have been designed by Dr. Payne and her team to provide each participant an in-depth look into poverty and facilitate participant understanding of class difference. Each participant will receive Dr. Payne's book, [A Framework for Understanding Poverty](#), and will have the opportunity to have their book signed by the author. After the completion of day 1, a GRREC certified trainer will guide participants through an interactive book study. Day 2 will begin with a member of Dr. Payne's team, Mr. Jim Littlejohn, sharing the impact of the framework and how the framework applies to the classroom. Participants will leave day 2 with concrete strategies that have been proven to impact the achievement of students in poverty, a better understanding of how economic class affects behaviors and mindsets, how to develop stronger relationships with students to impact behavior and achievement, and instructional strategies that meet the needs of the under-resourced learner.
