

Utilizing MAP to Drive Mathematics Instruction

Thursday, January 21, 2016

GRREC is pleased to offer two half-day sessions on utilizing Northwest Evaluation Association's (NWEA) Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Screening Data to drive instruction in K-8 mathematics classrooms. These workshops are designed to help classroom teachers, instructional coaches, curriculum coordinators and administrators navigate the NWEA system, and utilize appropriate reports as a guide to making informed decisions about mathematics instruction to support student learning and differentiation. The morning session will focus on grades K-5 while the afternoon session will be geared toward grades 6-8.

During this workshop, participants will:

- Use MAP reports to determine students meeting benchmarks
- Use MAP data to determine RtI needs
- Understand appropriate goal setting for students
- Make connections between KY Core Academic Standards and MAP
- Develop an increased understanding of the learning continuum and how it can be used to differentiate
