In partnership with Western Kentucky University, GRREC presents the New Teacher Academy, a professional learning opportunity for new teachers aspiring to grow and increase effectiveness. The New Teacher Academy is designed to equip teachers with 0-5 years' teaching experience in Kentucky schools with the necessary skills for a great beginning to the instructional process as well as provide professional support and resources throughout the school year.

Completion of designated tasks and participation in these sessions can count toward **credit in the WKU Master of Arts in Education graduate courses** TCHL 500 *Foundations for Teacher Leadership* and TCHL 545 *Classroom Instructional Strategies* if the participant is registered for these courses during the Spring 2016 semester.

Learning Targets:

- Participants will increase knowledge and implement strategies in classroom management, behavior management, PBIS, PGES and connections to the framework.
- Participants will increase knowledge and application of data and data analysis, observations and professional growth plans.
- Participants will increase understanding of legal rights and issues.
- Participants will increase knowledge of family engagement, models for strategic teaching, professional learning, and teacher leadership.
- Participants will revise a classroom management plan for year two, demonstrate the use of models for strategic teaching, and plan for sustainability.
