

PBIS Tier 2/3: Supporting Students through a Multi-Tiered System

Schools using a multi-tiered system of positive behavioral supports establish processes and interventions to meet the needs of students who have not fully responded to Tier 1 PBIS strategies. This four-day training is designed for school teams consisting of administrators, behavior specialists, teachers, and others to create a comprehensive system of supports.

School teams will

- Establish a process for identifying students in need of assistance
- Develop a continuum of Tier 2 group interventions
- Use data to evaluate the effectiveness of interventions
- Learn a process to develop a brief function-based intervention, including creating a behavior intervention pathway
- Differentiate between a brief and complex function-based intervention plan
- Evaluate student progress on individual behavior plans.

Training on the Behavior Education Program (informally called Check and Connect or Check In Check Out) is embedded within this training sequence.

Lisa Loague is the PBIS consultant at GRREC. She provides training and technical assistance to schools and districts in the implementation of the multi-tiered system of supports known as Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS).
