

## The Power of Self-Directed Evaluation Conversations

**Wednesday, June 29 and Thursday, June 30, 2016**

GRREC is pleased to offer a two-day professional learning event designed to help administrators develop the skills and knowledge to coach teachers and other professionals during the evaluation process. This workshop will focus on laying the foundation to building trust and rapport, differentiating between the four different support functions, and distinguishing between the three forms of feedback. As evaluators, administrators want to communicate in such a way that keeps the brain open to feedback. Understanding ways in which different types of feedback affect the brain will help evaluators have the greatest impact on thinking. The Calibrating Conversation Map will also be utilized to help administrators develop coaching skills that support teachers and other professionals in self-assessing their progress toward meeting professional growth goals.

**As a result of engaging in this institute, participants will:**

- Learn how to structure professional conversations by applying tools of Cognitive Coaching<sup>SM</sup> to the evaluation process
- Understand how evaluation can support self-directedness
- Demonstrate mediation skills & coaching capabilities, including paraphrasing and questioning
- Increase confidence in using evaluation as an opportunity to support professional growth
- Understand evaluation in the context of other support functions
- Increase their capacity to support teachers and other professionals in meeting their professional growth goals connected to Kentucky's Framework for Teaching (TPGES and OPGES)
