The Woodcock-Johnson IV is the updated and redesigned edition of one of the most widely used batteries of psychoeducational tests. Based on the evolution of Cattell-Horn-Carroll (CHC) theory, new tests and interpretive clusters have been developed to emphasize the most important and diagnostically useful measures of cognitive abilities, oral language, and academic achievement. This presentation will focus on 'what's new' with the WJIV, providing participants information on the new tests and a basic understanding of how the instrument can best be utilized in identifying learning problems and disabilities that are specified in IDEA.

Margaret L. Camp, PhD, National Clinical and Early Childhood Account Executive from Riverside Publishing, will lead participants through the Evidence-based Practices and how it relates to the Kentucky Alternate Assessment process.
